





Cyber Laws in India

What is a Cyber Crime?

It refers to any crime that involves Computer or Network. Cyber crime is technically defined as, “Offences that are committed against individuals or groups of individuals with a crime motive to intentionally harm the reputation of the victim or cause physical or mental harm to the victim directly or indirectly using modern telecommunication networks such as Internet (Chat rooms, email, groups (and mobile phones (SMS/MMS)”.

Examples of Cyber Crimes are

1. Hacking
2. Cyber Stalking
3. Cyber Defamation
4. Child Pornography
5. Harassment
6. Intellectual Property Crimes
7. Cyber Terrorism



Cyber Laws

IT Act, 2000 (as amended in 2008)

- Section 66 Hacking with computer system
- Section 66A Punishment for sending offensive messages through communication service, etc.
- Section 66C Punishment for Identity Theft
- Section 66D Punishment for cheating by personation using computer resource.
- Section 66E Punishment for Violation of Privacy
- Section 67A Punishment for publishing or transmitting of material containing sexual explicit act etc
- Section 67C Preservation and Retention of Information by intermediaries


The Last Day
